We are inclusive and have a lift for wheelchair users to access the main clubhouse and bar. Please check up to date games info on our website.

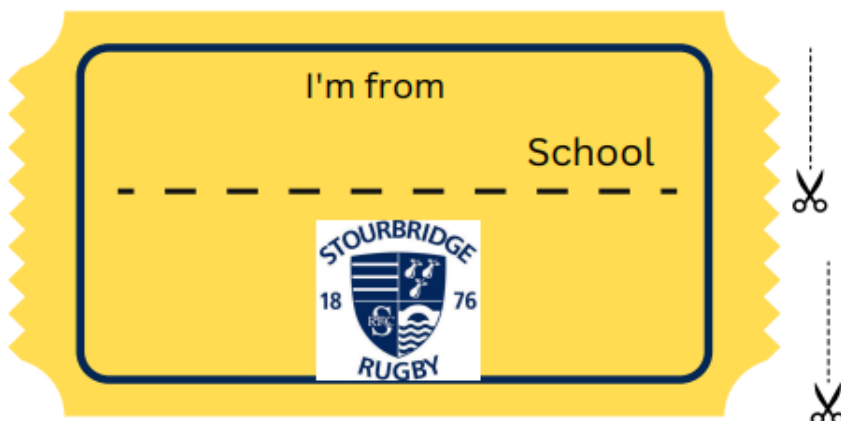
