


#### NEW recipe book for young people

#### Recipe of the term

This term's recipe has been taken from the new recipe book for young people.

## Chicken fajitas

#### Equipment

- Measuring spoon
- Chopping board
- Sharp Knife
- Frying pan

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 chicken breast or 1 large handful of quorn pieces or other meat substitute
- 1/2 onion, sliced
- 1 pepper, sliced
- 5 mushrooms, sliced
- 2 teaspoons of fajita seasoning
- Vegetable oil
- 2 tortilla wraps

#### Method

STEP 1 Cut the chicken breast and vegetables into strips

STEP 2 Heat a tablespoon of oil in a frying pan on a high heat. As soon as the oil begins to smoke add the chicken or meat substitute to the pan

Let the chicken cook undisturbed for 2 to 3 minutes, then turn it over and cook for

another 2 to 3 minutes until the outside is cooked well

Add the vegetables and fajita seasoning and cook for another 15 minutes, stirring well. Check the chicken is cooked through - cut through a piece and check the is not pink

STEP 5 Add some fajita chicken mix to a wrap and fold following the steps on page 40
